

- Dr. David Hodges, IEEE Awards Committee Chair, Indicated that the Resnik Award may be Discontinued due to Lack of Nominations
- Reason Stated was too Narrow of a Scope
- Sponsoring Societies are AESS (Prof. Marina Ruggieri), CSS (Dr. Roberto Tempo) & EMBS (Dr. Bin Ha/Dr. Jose Principe)
- CSS & EMBS have no Problem with the Scope, CSS Complaint is that only one Winner Since Inception (1989) was Control Oriented
- Spoke with Field Award Staff (Ellen Bucco) – IEEE Decided to Keep the Resnik Award on Probation for another Year
- The Problem ... **NOMINATIONS!**

- Committee Chairman Suggests New Committee Members
- Revise for IEEE to ask each Societies to Nominate Members

New “Transportation Technology” IEEE Field Award

- New Award Proposed by IEEE Awards Committee Chair, Dr. David Hodges
- Letter was addressed to AESS (Prof. Marina Ruggieri), CSS (Dr. Roberto Tempo) & VTS (Dr. Jae Hong Lee)
- Yearly Cost is \$15,000 plus a \$2,500 Startup Fee, to be Shared Equally by Sponsoring Societies (two minimum)
- Want a Firm 3-Year Commitment w/ Intention to Support for 10 Additional Years
- CSS has Decided NOT to Support the Award
- VTS will only Support Up to \$5,000
- Our Cost with VTS and AESS as Sponsors would be \$7,500/yr + \$1,250/startup
- Intelligence Transportation Systems (ITSS) was Suggested as an Additional Potential Sponsor (Dr. Alberto Broggi) – No Reply As Yet.
- Recommend that AESS does NOT Participate Due to the Nomination Issues, High Cost and Long-Term Commitment

Other Issues – Ghosts from the Past

- Provide Awards List
 - In Magazine /on Awards Website
- Get handle on Award Costs
 - Some are Sponsored by IEEE Foundation
 - Plaque Cost / Stipend / Number of Winners
- Put Nomination Process on Web
 - Pioneer is Online, will Work with Judy to Assure Others are too
- Provide Award Info – Pictures/Write-Up for Publications
 - Work with Dave Dobson & Judy to get the word out
- Make Mandatory to Present Pioneer Award at AESS Conferences
 - Not Always Possible, See Previous Slide on Venue Priorities
- Require an Article for the Magazine for each Award
 - Is Mandatory for the Pioneer Award Winner – 4000 Word for Transactions
 - Others are Best Paper Awards Already
 - Will Look into Others
